What is Denza?

Denza, the newest advancement in radiofrequency, is a significant leap forward in skin volumizing, tightening and contour-smoothing technology. It utilizes a proprietary Sequential Pulsing Technology to non-invasively smooth, tighten and thicken the skin in a single treatment with no surgery, no injections and little-to-no downtime.

How Does it Work?

The procedure works by using BOTH monopolar and bipolar radiofrequency technology to heat collagen fibers deep in the skin and underlying tissue. For the first time ever, using Sequential Pulsing Technology, the all-new Denza system has an improved, more uniform heating action that causes the structures in the skin and underlying tissue to immediately tighten, while stimulating collagen growth. Over time, new and remodeled collagen is produced to further tighten and contour the skin. With the only, available customized cooling system for this technology, treatments are the most comfortable they've ever been.

What Makes This More Comfortable?

The Denza system incorporates proprietary Sequential Pulsing Technology to deliver heat more broadly into the tissue, while including a new customizable 5-level cooling system and scientifically advanced treatment tips. The Sequential Pulsing Technology delivers energy more efficiently to the targeted treatment area, while the newly designed face, eye and body tips distribute heat more efficiently. The new 5-level custom cooling system has also been shown in clinical studies to provide a more comfortable experience, compared to versions of currently available monopolar only technology.

When Will Patients See Results?

Visible results are often immediate and improve over time. Measurable tightening and contouring improvements appear gradually over a 2-6-month period following a single treatment session.

How Many Treatments Are Needed?

Unlike many procedures requiring four or more sessions, most Denza patients benefit from a single treatment. The treating doctor will determine the course of treatment that is right for each patient, based on the patient's needs and goals.

Where on the Body Can a Denza Treatment be Performed?

The Denza is designed especially for treatments of the face and body. It can help tighten skin safely on most body parts, including the face, eyes, tummy, arms, hands, thighs and buttocks. Our most popular areas are face, neck, stomach, knees and lower eyelids.

How Long Does a Denza Treatment Take?

The Denza procedure is a completely non-invasive, safe treatment that is performed only in a doctor's office. Depending on the size and location of the area to be treated, the procedure may take as little as 20 minutes or up to one hour.



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Is There Any Special Preparation or Follow-Up Care?

No. Unlike surgery, there is no pre-procedure preparation, such as blood work or fasting required. Patients are typically given a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory medication 60 minutes prior to the procedure; however, many patients have Denza without pre-medication. With little to no downtime, most patients can return to their regular activities immediately following treatment. There is no special care after treatment. Some patients exhibit a temporary redness or minor swelling after treatment, this usually resolves within 24 hours. Good skin care and sunscreens are recommended as part of your regular skin care regimen. The only signs of treatment are naturally smoother, younger and healthier skin.

Can Patients Have Denza if They Have Had Previous Fillers?

Published clinical data shows that Denza is safe over most fillers including hyaluronic acid (Restylane/Juvederm), calcium hydroxyapatite (Radiesse) and Sculptra. Denza has not been tested over areas previously injected with silicone and should not be used over these areas.

Can Denza be Performed in Areas That Have Been Previously Treated by Lasers?

Yes! Denza is often used in combination with other modalities like the AgeJET or AdvaTX for vascular improvement to provide an overall comprehensive skin rejuvenation therapy. You can even them do them in the same treatment session back-to-back to provide the best results.

AdvaTX – Vascular and acne

AgeJET – Superficial energy that handles visible aging-skin conditions like texture/tone/wrinkles/pigment Denza – Deep dermal remodeling for skin tightening, volumizing, and increased contouring of facial features

How Long will the Results of a Denza Treatment Last?

The Denza procedure helps tighten existing collagen and stimulate new, natural collagen production for up to six months following the treatment. Results may last for years depending on the patient's skin condition and natural aging process.

Is Denza the Only Radiofrequency Technology on the Market Today?

While there are other skin care treatments that use traditional older versions of monopolar radiofrequency energy, Denza utilizes proprietary Sequential Pulsing Technology to deliver BOTH monopolar and bipolar radiofrequency energy at the same time to deliver uniform volumetric heating into the dermal and subcutaneous layers of the skin to help naturally tighten and contour underlying tissue. Also, Denza generally achieves results in a single treatment, compared to other technologies requiring multiple treatment sessions over several weeks.

How Much Does the Denza Treatment Cost?

Your physician will discuss the cost of the procedure at the time of the consultation, as it depends on the areas being treated. The cost typically is significantly less than comparable cosmetic surgery and the results are more natural looking.
